

## School Uniform

Telopea Park School students are required to wear **school uniform**.

Students, parents and teachers are expected to support the school uniform.

Students out of school uniform are not permitted beyond the 3-storey building and the large blue gates onto the Oval during recess and lunchtime.

*A student out of school uniform is NOT permitted to attend a school excursion.*

The wearing of school uniform serves a number of purposes that are of benefit to the school community. It enables acceptable standards of dress to be maintained and provides students with a means of identifying with and demonstrating their commitment and pride in the school.

**Tops** – white collared shirt, white polo shirt, navy sweatshirt, jacket, blazer, navy woollen jumper, navy weatherproof jacket

**Bottoms** – navy blue, trousers, shorts, pleated skirt or summer dress. No 'short' shorts.

**Footwear** – clean black (preferably leather) shoes or sports shoes (no open toes, or slip-on shoes)

**PE Uniform** – Students **MUST** change for PE

Tops – school PE polo shirt (preferably) or plain navy polo shirt

Bottoms – navy shorts or navy track pants

Shoes – sports shoes

No offensive or dangerous jewellery is to be worn at school.

No tops with offensive words or pictures are to be worn at school.
